

Community Employment

WorkForce Diversity is a program designed to help those with disabilities find and maintain community employment.

The Howard County Commissioners funded an internship program to provide job skills training and internships to clients at local businesses.

We offer Pre-Employment Training Services (Pre-ETS) that help with job talent discovery, work-based learning experience and workplace readiness training for high school students ages 14 to 22.

Bona Vista's Early Childhood Services

encompasses Keys for Kids Early Education Center, Early Head Start, Child Care Solutions and Positive Results for Kids Pediatric Therapies.

13 children graduated from Keys for Kids preschool and were better prepared for Kindergarten



344 children received physical, occupational, developmental or speech therapy services through Positive Results for Kids, 34 went through Developmental Screenings sponsored by United Way, and 21 went through mini-screenings sponsored by We Care



17,513
meals served to children in our services

154 children ages 0-3 in Early Head Start reached child development goals focusing on physical, language, literacy, cognitive, social emotional and their approach to learning.



6 teachers received TEACH scholarships to further their education

Adult Services

The BV Bistro, one of the newest additions to Bona Vista, is a food safety and preparation service provided to our adults that now offers catering service to the public.

Respite Services are provided in the home of the primary caregiver or the community to offer a relief period of rest to the regular caregiver.




