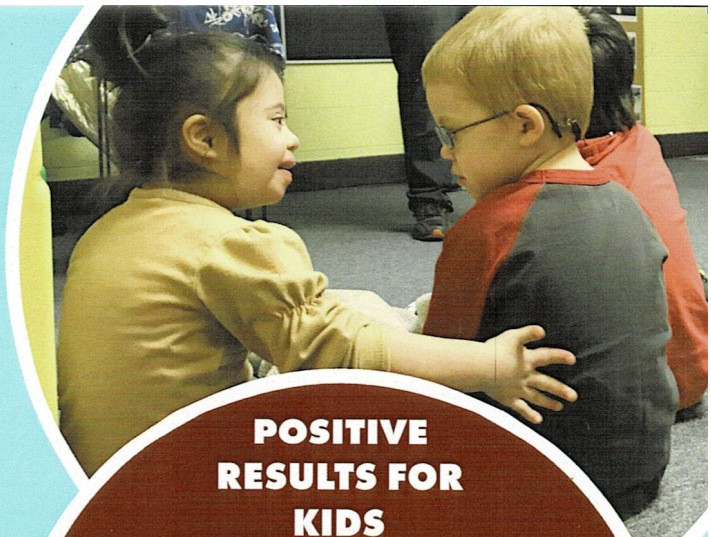

EARLY HEAD START

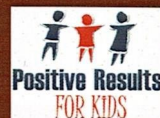


Early Head Start is a federally funded, comprehensive child development program, which serves pregnant woman and children age birth to three years of age. We offer center-based, home-based, combination and prenatal services, which are all free of charge to those who meet the income guidelines. Our Center-Based Child Care is state licensed, NAEYC accredited and has a 4 star rating for Paths to Quality.

Our Home-Based Program offers weekly home visits and two group socializations a month. Our Prenatal Program offers prenatal visits and a Parents 2 Be Meeting once a month. Early Head Start is dedicated to involving parents in every aspect of our program.

POSITIVE RESULTS FOR KIDS

The licensed staff at Positive Results for Kids provides personalized treatment in our outpatient therapy center, the preschool classroom or in the home. Physical, occupational, speech/language and developmental therapies are offered through the First Steps Program to children newborn to three years old. Additionally, we provide free developmental screenings for children in Howard and the surrounding counties. Our therapists work in collaboration to provide the best possible care for children ages birth to eighteen years of age.



CHILD CARE SOLUTIONS



Child Care Solutions is a FREE child care resource and referral agency serving 11 counties in

KEYS FOR KIDS EARLY EDUCATION CENTER

Keys for Kids Early Education Center is an

innovative program specially designed to help unlock your child's possibilities. Our

developmental preschool programs develop skills through structured play and academic activities. The classes are taught by teachers with higher education certifications or degrees in early childhood. We provide full-day programs to children six weeks to six years of age with or without special needs. WORKFORCE DIVERSITY



WorkForce Diversity (WFD) has been providing career placement services for over 50 years. Our Employment Specialists know the local job climate and participate in local and state activities that relate to the employment and the economy. We work with employees who need prescreened, dependable job candidates; job seekers and career

changers, high school students and recent graduates searching for vocational direction. All individuals must be eligible for services through Indiana Vocational Rehabilitation Services (Voc Rehab) or Ticket to Work through the Social Security Administration. WFD is also a Pre-Employment Transition Services provider that offers job talent discovery, work-based learning experiences and workplace readiness training for high school students ages 14 to 22. WFD is also a School-to-Work Transition Project in Grant and Cass Counties! WFD staff are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, to work with clients on the job.

PROGRAMS & SERVICES FOR ADULTS

OPPORTUNITY KNOCKS!



Opportunity Knocks (OK!) is a day services program at Bona Vista that addresses the need for job training for individuals prior to beginning the Vocational Rehabilitation process. OK! focuses on a curriculum that has modules based on different job industries. This program will work with individuals on job readiness skills, such as resume creation, interview skills, hygiene, social media use and professional communication with others. The persons served will also have the opportunity to meet and listen to speakers from local businesses. Individuals in the program will be referred to Vocational Rehabilitation when staff determine that they are ready to look for work in the community.

RESIDENTIAL



Residential Programming offers services for eligible adults with developmental delays, and who may also have mental, physical or emotional challenges. The individuals served range in age and have varying levels of functioning. Home and community based assistance is an alternative to institutional care. In this type of setting, we can focus on the development of skills for daily living, including household chores, personal care, budgeting, grocery shopping and leisure activities. Bona Vista operates eight group homes in Howard and Miami Counties.

SUPPORTED LIVING



Supported Living Services provides residential support in the home of the clients served. We provide as little as one hour a week and can range up to 24 hours a day. While receiving Supported Living Services, a person served works on individualized goals that are developed during the team meeting of the person served. Our goals range from daily living skills, residential management, budgeting, shopping, community integration, financial management and management of medical needs.

BEHAVIOR MANAGEMENT



Behavior Management therapists work alongside the individuals team, consisting of staff, family and case management, to identify behavioral issues that hinder the individuals from reaching their maximum potential. Once issues are identified, the therapist then puts together strategies through a behavior support plan to monitor and appropriately address the behavioral concerns.

COMMUNITY CONNECTIONS



Community Connections provides day programming for adults with severe and profound disabilities. Individuals in Community Connections receive intense supervision during a variety of classes that create a meaningful day. Activities are based on each persons served individual needs in the areas of daily living skills, social opportunities, personalized goals and volunteer opportunities. Community Connections works cooperatively with licensed therapists, nurses, social workers and/or behavior consultants to assist individuals in reaching their highest potential.

WELLNESS COORDINATION



Wellness Coordination Services are based on the development, maintenance and routine monitoring of the client's Wellness Coordination Plan and medical services required to manage his/her health care needs. These services extend beyond those services provided through routine doctor/health care visits required under the Medicaid State Plan, and are specifically designed for the participants requiring assistance of a Registered Nurse (RN) or Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) to properly coordinate their medical needs.

COMMUNITY BASED HABILITATION-INDIVIDUAL (CHIO)



The Community Based Habilitation-Individual (CHIO) Program is a goal based program that includes services outside the individual's home, that support learning and assistance in the areas of: self-care, sensory/motor development, socialization, daily living skills, communication, community living and social skills. Community based activities are intended to build relationships and natural supports.

RESPIRE (RSPO)

Respite Service is a non-goal based services. Respite Care is typically provided in the home of the primary caregiver, however it can be provided in the community. Respite Care offers relief or a period of rest to the regular caregiver.



HABILITATION



Habilitation Services provides individual and group training classes to adults with disabilities. These 30 to 60 minute classes focus on goal-centered activities that may include, but are not limited to, daily living skills, independent living skills, educational opportunities, computer skills and social skills. Habilitation instructors work closely with the clients to assist them in reaching their personal goals.

SKY'S THE LIMIT



Sky's The Limit is an innovative adult day program that offers a select number of classes that our adult individuals will partake in to provide a meaningful day. The goal is to continue to increase our possibilities as we learn more of what each individual in the Sky's the Limit program would like to do each day to succeed. A day in Sky's the Limit includes a short social time in the morning to get acquainted with one another. Sky's the Limit has one morning session and an interactive lunch. The afternoon sessions includes two more classes. We offer a variety of classes focused on current events, relationships, cooking and many more creative topics. Each individual has goals which may include focusing on a task, answering questions, developing fine motor skills, implementing healthy lifestyles and practicing social skills. Adults work individually and in small groups as they work through a meaningful day.

ACTION. INSPIRED. MOTIVATED. (AIM)



The Action. Inspired. Motivated. (AIM) Program is an adult day program that encompasses multiple strategies that allow for career exploration with opportunities for meaningful community and leisure activities. Participants in the AIM Program will have the opportunity to participate in multiple program sections that cohesively fit together. The program sections are: Job Exploration and Entrepreneurship, Work-Based Learning Experiences, Workplace Readiness, Instruction in Self-advocacy, and Leisure Activities. Staff will assist persons served to find and succeed in a program of their liking. This program allows for hands-on experience in an environment that allows for exploration and creativity while gaining important life skills.

BONA VISTA BISTRO & THE CORNER DÉCOR



These are the two newest additions to Bona Vista! The BV Bistro is a food safety and preparation service provided to our adults that now offers catering services to the public! The Corner Décor is a home goods/gift store located at 127 N. Buckeye Street, Kokomo. This store is stocked with items created by the individuals in our AIM program.



PARTICIPANTS ASSISTANCE AND CARE (PAC)

The Participants Assistance and Care (PAC) Services are provided to assist persons served to live successfully in their own homes. PAC Services is a non-goal based program that can be provided outside or inside the home of the person served. PAC services support learning and assistance in the areas of: daily living skills, self-care, scheduling appointments, paying bills, chores, cooking meals and leisure activities.
