President's Corner



Bona Vista has two important building projects going on at this time. One was born out of the aftermath of the November 2013 tornado and the other is focused upon providing safe and affordable housing for our adults in the Supported Living Program. A great deal of time and attention has gone into both projects. The Imagine That facility will be the new home of the Community Connections Program and we are in desperate need of the space. The new building will offer our clients new bathrooms that will more easily address their needs, open space with natural light that will shine into the various classrooms where multiple activities will take place. The curriculum for our adults will be expanded to address additional programs in the arts, horticulture, story-telling and prevocational activities. In the evenings and the weekends, the building will be used for training and early childhood activities that will be designed for the community at large.

The housing project is designed for eleven adults with developmental disabilities who are receiving Waiver Services through Bona Vista Programs. The project will consist of three houses, two houses will have four bedrooms and the third house will have

three bedrooms. This project will also have a community building for structured and leisure time activities for the adults residing in our homes. This project is funded through the Federal Home Loan Bank and the Indiana Housing Development Authority. Bona Vista is very fortunate that we were selected to receive grants for this important housing project.

The Imagine That Facility is partially funded through insurance proceeds related to the destruction of the building, but these dollars will not cover the entire costs for the rebuild. The new building has so many new architectural features related to the physical needs of our adults and children for areas such as bathrooms and the kitchen. There is so much to take into consideration that most of us take for granted. Opening a door for example can be very challenging if it is too heavy! Pushing a wheelchair up to a sink can be difficult if the height or the design of the sink are not accessible.

Thus, Bona Vista is in the middle of a campaign to raise the dollars needed for the new building as well as to properly furnish the facility upon its completion. Grants Galore!



Two of Bona Vista's Early Childhood Programs have been awarded grants that will enhance the learning and overall experience for children in our Keys for Kids Preschool and Early Head Start Program. We are grateful to receive the following grants and implement further high quality care at Bona Vista Programs.

Champions for Healthy Kids has granted \$20,000 to Early Head Start and Keys for Kids to improve the health and wellness of children. This is a nationwide initiative to encourage positive lifestyles through healthy eating and play.

With funds from this grant, we will help children grow fruits and vegetables to incorporate into healthy lunches and snacks. We will work with a registered dietician to create meals for family events that are healthy, tasty and cost effective. Bona Vista will also establish natural playgrounds where kids enrolled in our programs can engage in active play to build skills such as balance, strength, and coordination.

Staff will benefit from the Champions for Healthy Kids grant by receiving training specifically focused around healthy eating and incorporating fresh seasonal fruits and vegetables in all meals and snacks served to children at Bona Vista Programs.

Families will play an integral part in continuing this lifestyle at home. We will host a family event each month where Bona Vista's Early Childhood Programs will feature fun, healthy meals and active play activities. Family involvement is key.

Our second grant was awarded by **Delta Dental**. We received \$1,600 from Delta Dental to educate staff and families on dental care for infants and toddlers. The grant includes funding for training, resources for classroom activities, and information for families! Healthy smiles make happy children.

Lastly, Bona Vista received \$595 from the **Reading is Fundamental, Inc.** (RIF) grant. This money was used to purchase 296 books for our Early Childhood Services! The vision of RIF is to provide children across America with access to books and to help them discover the joys and value of reading. Thanks to this grant, we are able to offer more learning and reading opportunities for the children at Bona Vista Programs.

Thank you to all those who have awarded Bona Vista's Early Childhood Programs grants to enrich the lives and improve the level of care at our facilities.






The Rebuild of Imagine That! **Innovation Center**

The Imagine That building is much more than walls and a roof. It's a tribute to the people Bona Vista provides services to on a daily basis. The new building has been designed to accommodate the Bona Vista Community Connections Program. Community Connections is an adult day program with over thirty individuals who are physically unable to care for themselves. Some cannot feed themselves independently, toilet themselves alone or socialize without close supervision due to their physical and intellectual limitations.

In addition to day programming, the *Innovation Center* will host a variety of trainings, family engagement activities, and community events in the evenings and on the weekends. Trainings and educational seminars will include topics such as challenging behaviors, the autism spectrum, sensory integration, and mental illness. The new facility will brighten the corner of Plate and Hoffer Street and bring life back to an empty lot. The staff at Bona Vista and most importantly, the people receiving services, deserve to have a wonderful space where each step they take is another step toward reaching their maximum potential.

We broke ground March 16, 2015, and we are seeing the building grow more each day! Take a look at our building progress and what our building will look like when completed.
