### **President's Corner**

We are happy to introduce to you our newest project "The VISTA", two homes for eight adults who are part of our Supported Living Program. The project is fully funded through the Indiana Housing Community Development Authority and the Indiana Federal Home Loan Bank. Community First Bank is our sponsoring bank and we appreciate their support on this project.

The project will also be the second Green Project in our community. It will be at the silver level and we are pleased about that as well. First and foremost, we are going to be able to offer safe and accessible housing to four women and four men who qualify for the project. We are hoping to break ground this coming January and the type of winter we have will determine our completion date. The Vista is on Plate Street directly across the street from the Crossing so please stop by and view it as the building begins!

Bona Vista is also in an expansion mode. We are providing a host of adult services in Hamilton and Madison Counties. Our Workforce Diversity staff has visited with several high schools in both Hamilton and Madison Counties in order to help facilitate job placements for young adults graduating from school. The students would be graduating with certificates and will be looking for a School to Work Successful Transition Program.



Bona Vista does an excellent job of providing these needed services. It is very important that the young adult finds meaningful and steady employment after they complete their high school curriculum. The meetings with the high schools have gone well and have been embraced by many of the school corporations.

Our reach into Hamilton and Madison County has also allowed us to open day services to adults who have waiver services. ## **Medicaid Waiver Changes**

Bona Vista is dedicated to keeping our employees, clients and supporters informed of any changes made within our government. Recently, there have been some changes with Medicaid Waiver Services. Effective September 1, 2012, the Supported Services Waiver (SS) is now the Family Support Waiver (FSW), and the Autism Waiver and Developmental Disability Waiver (DD) is now the Community Integration & Habilitation Waiver (CIH).

Some facts that you should be aware of regarding the Waivers:

- If a person is currently on the wait list for any of DDRS waivers Autism (ASD), Developmental Disability (DD), or Support Services (SS) they will be moved to the Family Support Waiver (FSW) wait list and targeted for the FSW by the earliest application date that they have submitted. **They will not have to reapply for any waiver**, and their position on the wait list will be the same as it was on ASD, DD or SS wait lists.
- If a person is currently on the SS waiver, they will automatically begin receiving services through the FSW. These individuals will receive the same services and benefits as they were on the SS waiver, as the new waiver is exactly the same, only named differently and includes two more services and an increased cap. **They will not need to do anything.**
- If a person is on the ASD or the DD waiver, they will automatically continue receiving their services through the Community Integration & Habilitation (CIH) Waiver. These individuals will receive the same services and benefits as they were on the ASD or DD waivers, as the new waiver is exactly the same, only named differently. **They will not need to do anything.**
- An application has been submitted for the increase in funding (from \$13,500 to \$16,250) on the Family Supports Waiver (FSW).
- The FSW is a capped waiver, but soon will be expanding to cover direct care service for in-home support.

### Imagine That!




